## Tulsa Architecture Tour

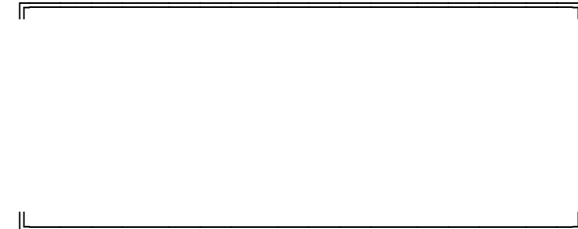
Tulsa Self-Guided Architecture Tour
